There is no charge for a temporary permit. <u>Permits must be on file in the front office before a student may drive to school.</u> Documentation of valid driver's license and proof of insurance must be presented. Failure to obtain a permit will result in a disciplinary referral.		
	Vehicles parked improperly in the parking area may be towed away at the owner's expense.		
	Hang-tags must be displayed when a car is parked in the Cass Career Center parking lot. Students "sharing" hang tags will receive discipline referrals, and/or driving permits will be pulled permanently.		
	Students driving unsafely, driving without permission, not obeying traffic signs, driving between buildings, or transporting riders will receive a discipline referral.
